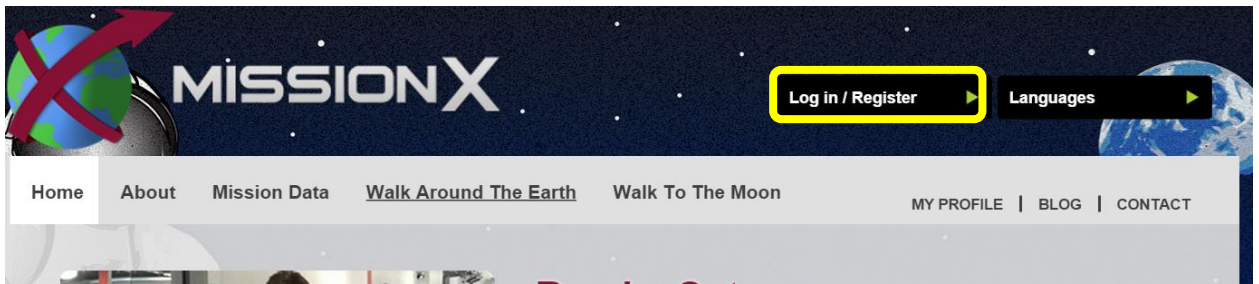



How to Register for a MX Account

1. Click on Login/Register



2. Select "Create New Account" tab
